A1. Interviews: Sample description

Interviews were conducted between January and February 2025. All interviews were conducted by the same interviewer, on Zoom. The average length of the interview was 57 minutes. Five interviewees were men and two women. The interviewees ranged in age from 31 to 69. No one was a member of the Greens; two were members of the Italian Left before the 2024 EP elections; one got their membership afterwards; four were not members of either Italian Left or the Greens, neither before the election nor at the time of the interview. Two interviewees were from northern Italy, from the Red Zone, one from the South. Three were from the main city in their region (i.e., “capoluogo di regione”); two from a town below one hundred thousand inhabitants; one from a town below fifty thousand inhabitants; and one from a very small town of only a few thousand inhabitants. Three were retired, and the remaining four had at least one university degree. A summary of the interviewee profiles is provided in the table below.

A2. Interview guide, as submitted to the Committee for Ethical Approval

(Translated to English from Italian)

The interviews will be semi-structured, meaning the interviewee will be left free to talk but will also be asked a few specific questions which are supposed to guide the flow of the conversation. In line with the theory on party identification and ideology and voting behavior (Miller 1991), voting habits and voting behavior (Dinas 2012), leaders and voting behavior (Garzia et al., 2020), and the importance of issue voting (De Sio & Lachat, 2020), we plan to ask the following questions (unless the respondent spontaneously provides such information):

- Why did you vote for AVS in the last European election?
- Are you currently member of any party?
- Have you ever been member of any party? If yes, why are you not anymore?
- Is there any party you feel closer to?
- Could you attempt to rank the parties from the one you feel closest to you to the one you feel farthest from you?
- Was it the first time you voted for AVS? If not, do you remember in which occasions you had already voted for them?
- Do you tend to vote for the same party – over the years, and in different electoral contests (national, European, regional, city) – or are you more the type who “starts from scratch” in every election?
- What do you think of the leaders of the main parties in Italy?
- Do you know the leaders of AVS? Do you like them?
- Did you express any preference back in June? Why?
- What is your opinion on the candidates for AVS in the last European election?
- When you think about politics, is there any issue that concerns you in particular?
